In Design and Technology this week year 3 have been designing, making and evaluating musical instruments while listening to Vivaldi's Four Seasons.






In DT, year one have been designing their own monster calendar. As a class we planned what we wanted our class calendar to look like and the children designed their own monsters using a computer software called Paint.
