



## The 48 hour rule

If your child has vomiting and/or diarrhoea they must remain at home until **they have been free of symptoms for 48 hours.**

Can we remind parents that if your child is sick please remember to phone school as early as possible to advise us of the absence. If you do not phone school this initiates concerns over the whereabouts and safety of your child and you will receive a call from the school. Should your child be absent for more than 2 days medical evidence may be required from your GP.
