Halton Arts Primary Network at the Cronton Playhouse.

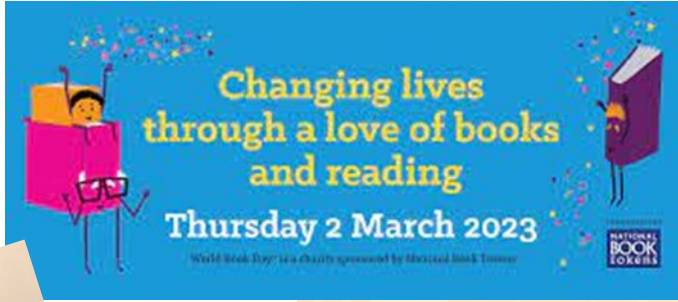
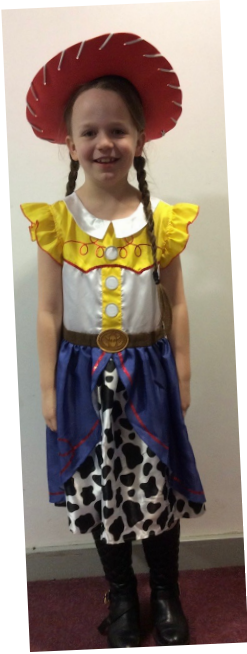
The theme for the night was 'A step back in time'

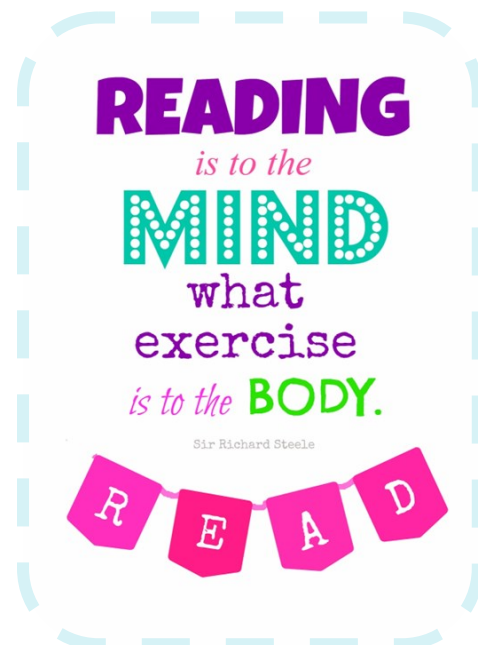

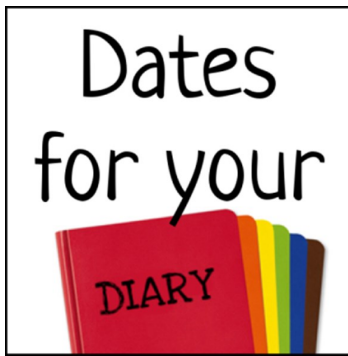
