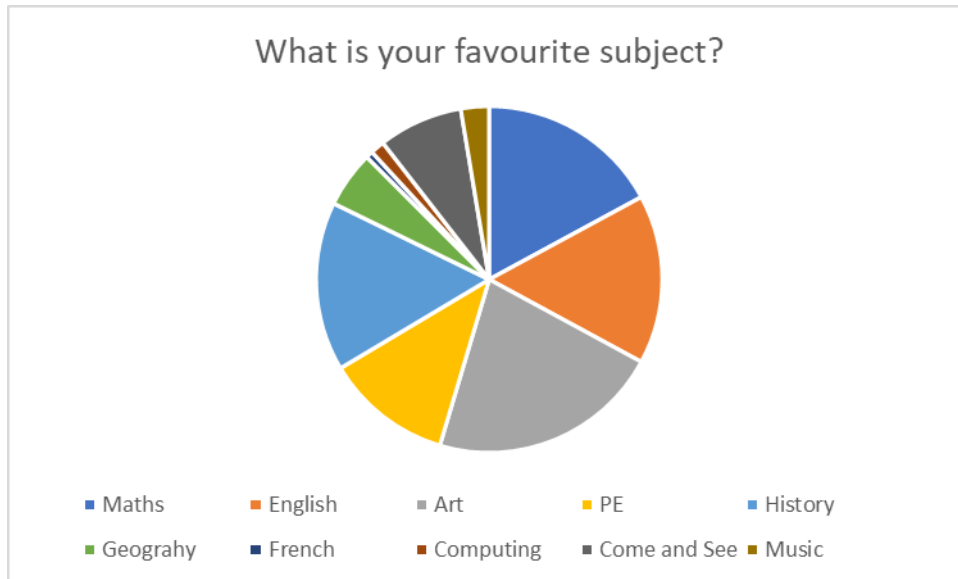

ACTIONS:

- Consult with 8% children who answered 'not often/never' to attending activities outside of lessons - maybe there is a club we could put on to interest these children.
- Staff Meeting - Challenging Children - children feel that in some areas they are not being challenged - this is mainly due to the teacher not 'labelling' it a challenge. Teachers to work on 'Presenting Challenges' so that ALL children feel challenged and/or realise that they are being challenged.
- 3% children who answered negatively about bullying - investigate further. PSHE sessions/individual sessions if required.
- 1 child who answered negatively about emotional/mental health - investigate further with class teacher/pastoral lead.
- Negative behaviour responses - support where necessary/positive behaviour sessions/rewards to amplify in this class.
