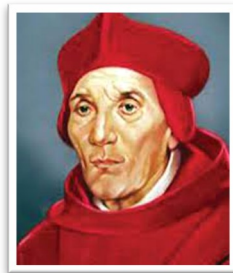

Please come along and support us. If anyone can donate cakes please bring them in on Friday for the Fair.

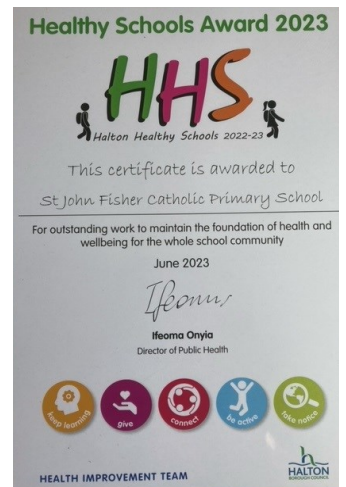


Sports Day Friday 30th June.
