They all enjoyed playing safely in the freshly fallen snow.

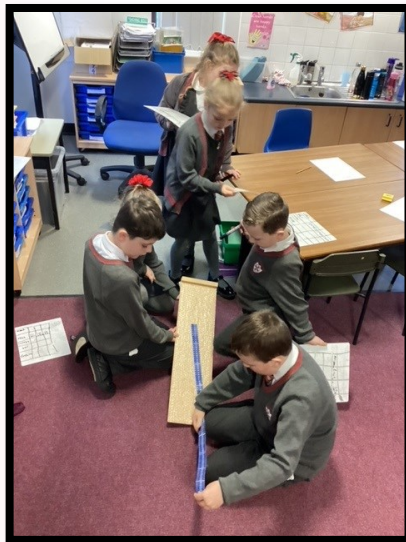
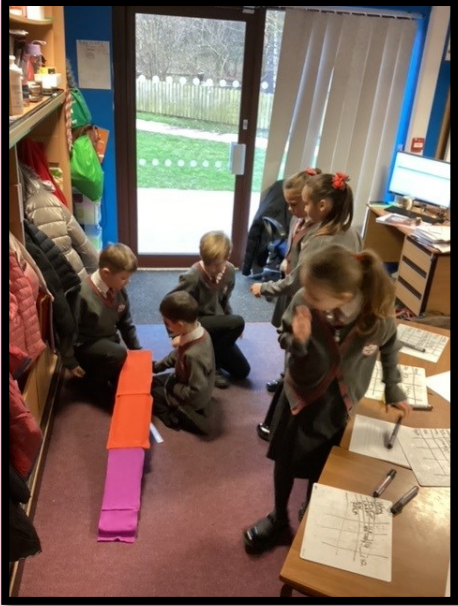
Year 1

This week Year 3 have been experimenting with friction by using different surfaces to measure distance.

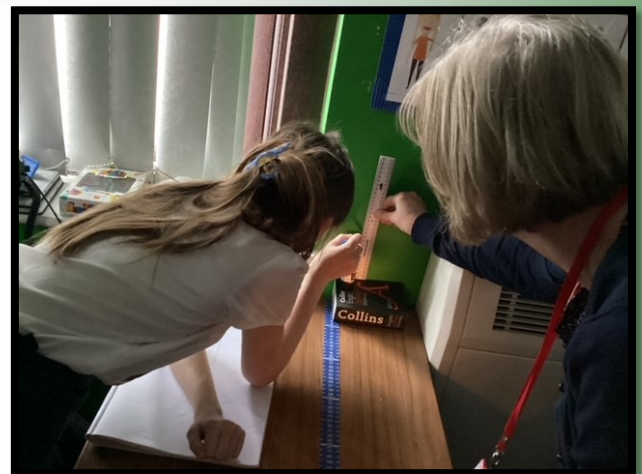
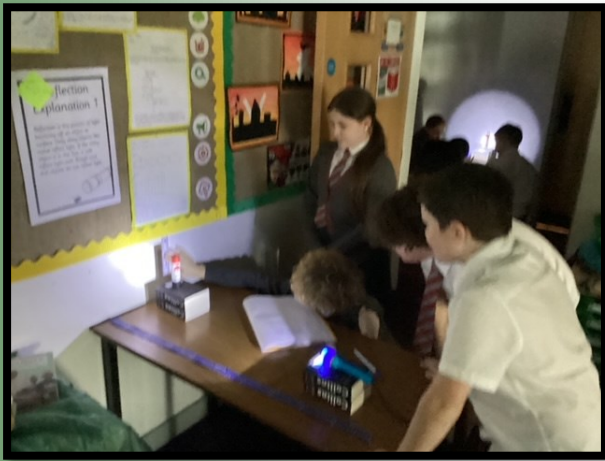
