



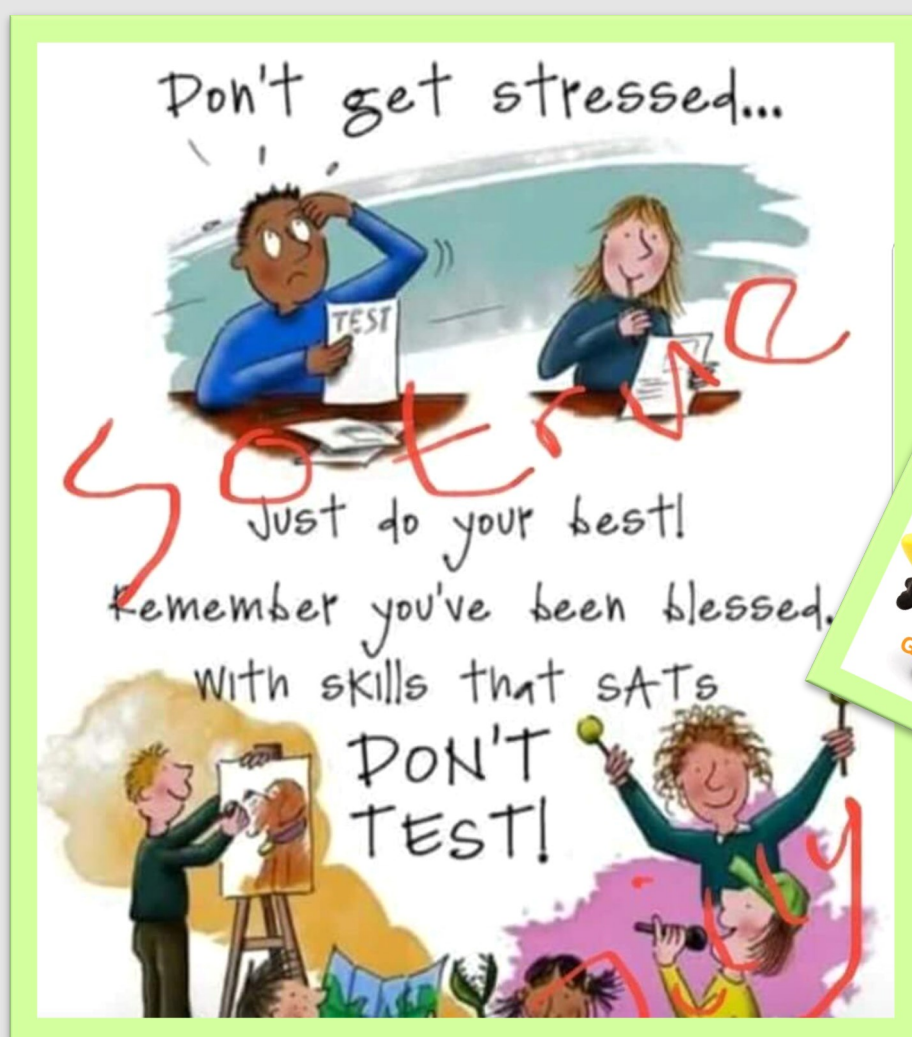

to our Year 6 as they sit the SAT tests next week




Dear God, please bless our year 6 children as they sit their tests.

May they give their best then knowing it's in your hands. Amen

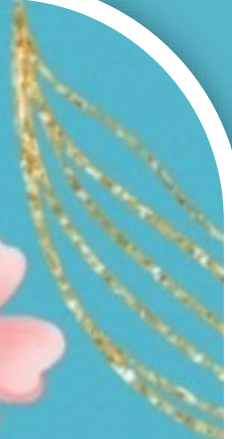
May is the month of Mary
