PARKING AROUND THE SCHOOL AT DROP OFF AND COLLECTION

Can we please ask that you do not park or manoeuvre outside the gates when dropping off/collecting. As you can appreciate the school is situated in a side road which makes parking difficult so we would ask that you park elsewhere rather than risk manoeuvring on Edward Street.

We understand that you are all busy and have places to go of a morning and evening but please lets not wait for a child to be hurt.



As we start a new school year please note the following:

- Juice or flavoured water is not allowed in water bottles.
- Year 1 and 2 do not require snacks—they are provided with fruit.
- Healthy snacks only for KS2.
- If you are not able to collect your child and are sending someone different to normal please notify the school office so that we can be confident that your child is collected safely.
- All appointment letters/texts must to be seen at the Office.
- We are often asked to pass on leaflets from external sports, dance and drama clubs. We do this to help support the local community but they are not affiliated with or endorsed by the school.
