Anna told the children that it costs as little as 10p to feed 1 child at school meal. That is £19.95 for a whole school year. She spoke to the about a vitamin enriched porridge that the children have and how it helps them to concentrate and do their learning.

Anna invited the school to become a 'Mary's Meal's ' Ambassador school.
