Young Catholics in Widnes

Our new 18-35's group met successfully for the first time last Sunday! 13 young adults (including me) came along, a real result! The evening began with adoration and benediction and was followed by some refreshments. During our time together, we held a discussion to decide on what we want to explore together as a group. We did this with regard to the two dimensions that will give form to future gatherings; prayer/ faith opportunities and social opportunities (including trips). So, this is what the young adults of our parish want:

Prayer/ faith opportunities; prayer with the bible, bible discussion, general faith discussion, evening prayer (also known as vespers), rosary, mass, prayer in latin, taizé prayer, prayer walks outdoors, praying with the saints, reconciliation services. **Social opportunities;** drinks nights, cheese and wine nights, meals, quiz nights (religious themed and generally themed), bowling, walks, BBQs, icon painting, pottery painting/making. **Possible trips;** a day pilgrimage to Holywell and Pantasaph in Wales/ Ladyewell Shrine near Preston, a pilgrimage to do the 'Camino' to Santiago de Compostela, a pilgrimage to Rome.

Our next meeting is scheduled for **Sunday 23rd March, 6 till 8**, at **St. Bede's**, during which we will spend some time praying with and reflecting on a bible passage and then share some cheese and wine together with a quiz. We are looking for as many members as possible, so come along and do spread the word! Please pray for this new group. We are the future of the Church in Widnes.

Parish Pilgrimage to Lourdes 2025

Thank you to all who attended the initial meeting to express interest in our parish pilgrimage to Lourdes this year. We have now received further information from the tour operator and can progress the group booking arrangements. The revised dates for the pilgrimage are confirmed as **Wednesday 23rd July to Thursday 31st July 2025**. We will travel as **one group** on these dates.

We have block booked rooms for the parish in the **Hotel Roissy**, located 100 metres from the entrance of Lourdes Sanctuary. This 4-star hotel offers soundproofed and air-conditioned rooms with free Wi-Fi and a flat-screen satellite TV. The cost (without single room supplement but including the extra night due to the changed dates), is £1,075.00. We require a **deposit of £350.00** by cash or cheque made payable to 'Northern Star Travel Ltd' to secure your place.

To progress our group booking we ask that all pilgrims attend a short meeting in St Bede's presbytery at **7pm on Wednesday 12th March** to fill out a 'completion of booking' form and to pay the deposit. There may be an opportunity for anyone who hasn't expressed an interest so far to join us. Please come along if you are interested.

We take another step on our restoration journey, as the scaffolding around the tower begins to come down. We can see a number of changes, the most obvious being the new bottle green colour for the bell louvres, which our architect believes is the original colour. We can also see new lead-work on the tower roof, new dressed stone, the restored downspouts, new pointing and the repaired 'grotesques' (stone carvings of mythical beasts). The nave roof is also progressing nicely, with a great number of the new tiles in place already. Please keep the work of the project in your prayers.
