£1 donation per child but please ask friends and family to support us with cash donations however large or small.

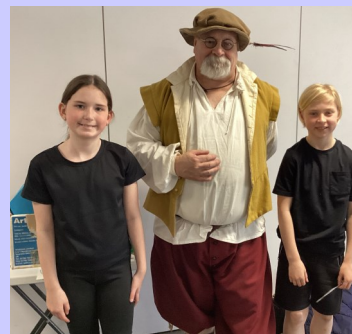
Children can wear their own clothes for the walk and the Disco in the afternoon. (Clothing suitable for the walk).

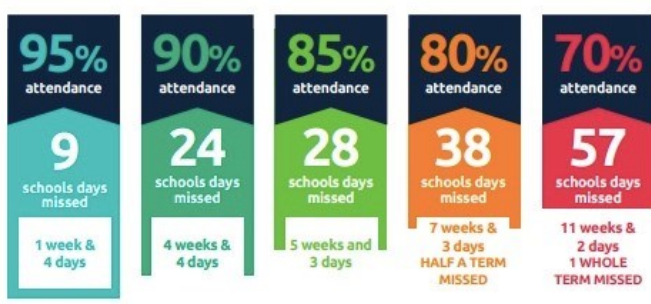


Tomsk has been in Year 1 this week helping the children recycle.
