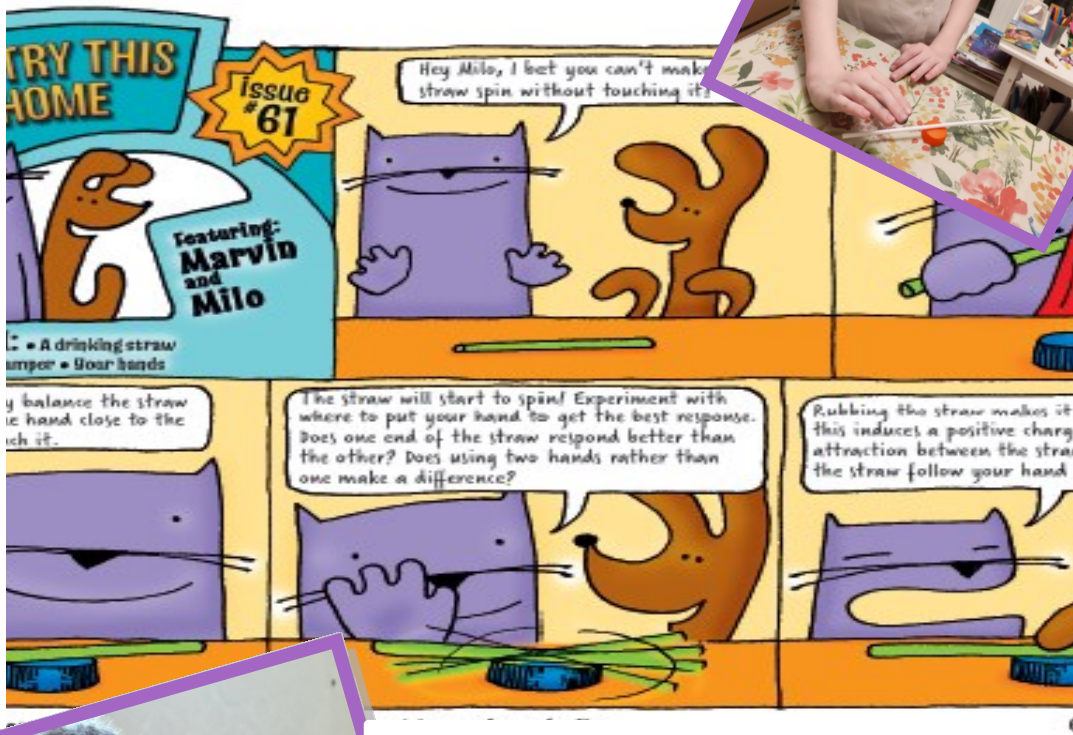


The ground works are well under way and the reception children are so excited watching the digger and dumper truck in action.

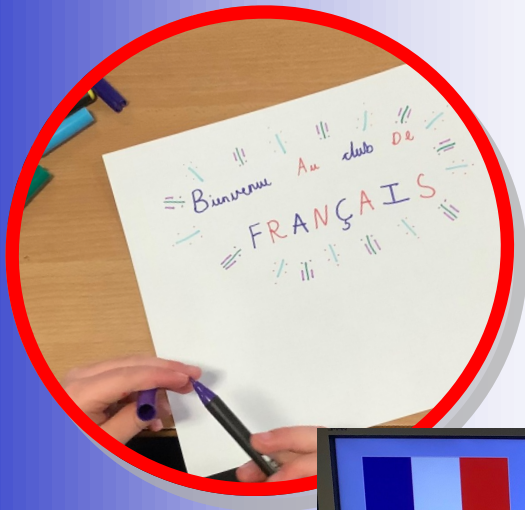
Year 1 have been learning about why and how different birds build their nests, They used natural materials to make their own nesting boxes.

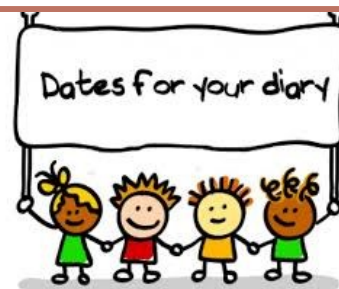
