They studied electrical safety, road safety, online safety and how to stay safe around train lines.



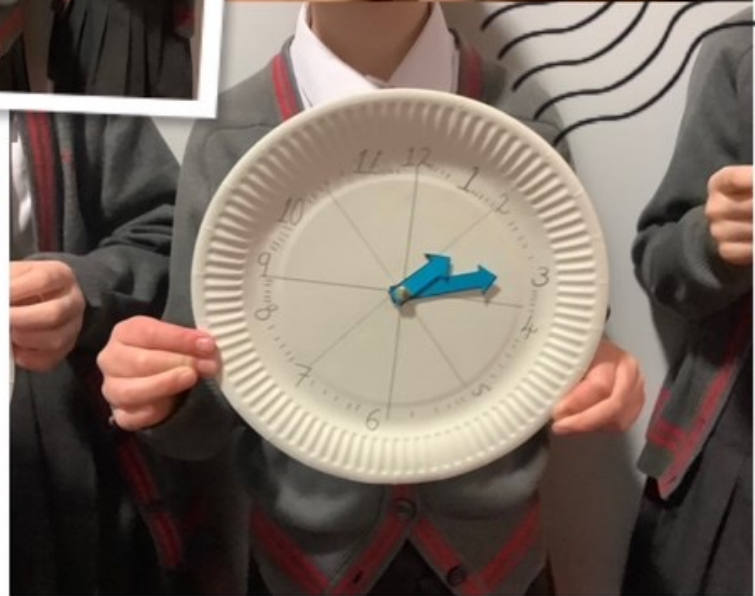
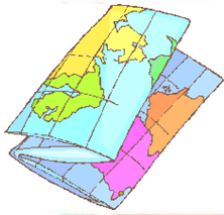
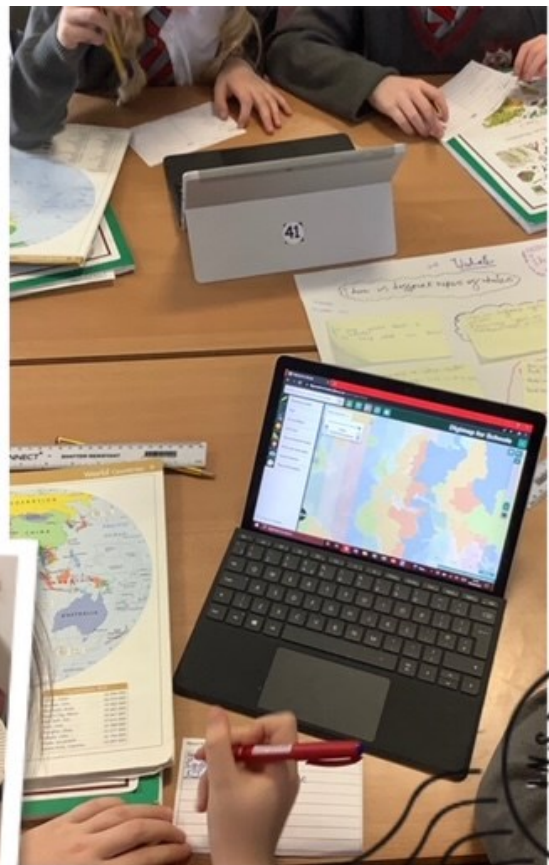
Reception children have been reading the book-

This week year 2 have been exploring the history of communication.

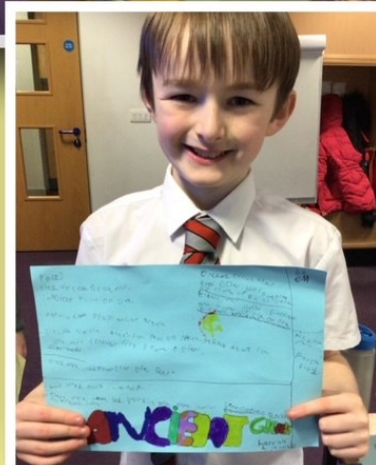
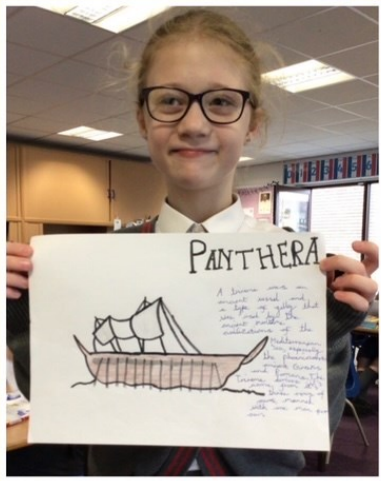
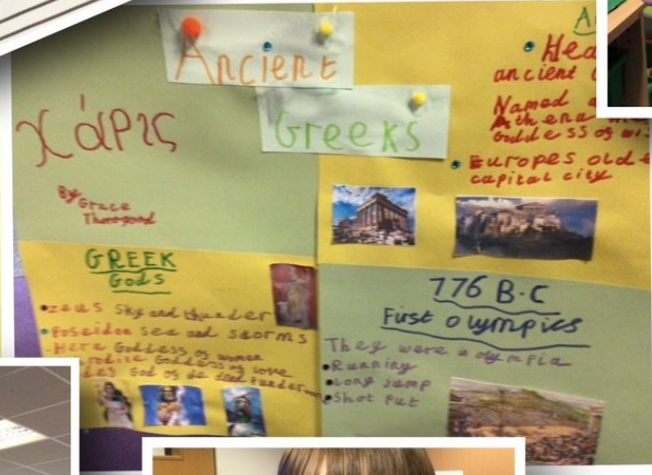
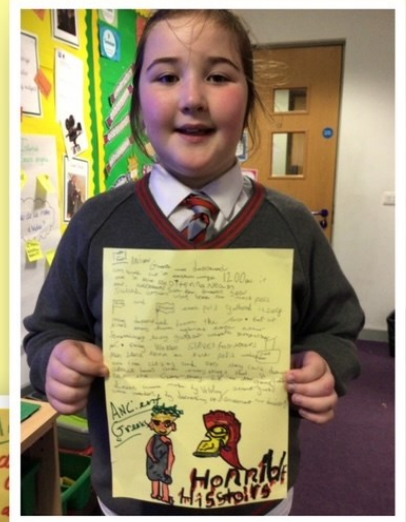
How did people communicate a long time ago?
