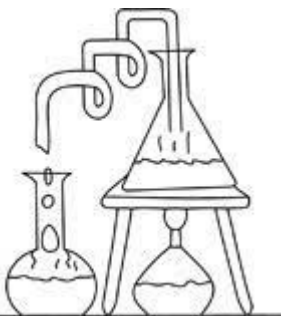

All the children enjoyed a session with Professor Chas from Sublime Science and observed several fascinating experiments.



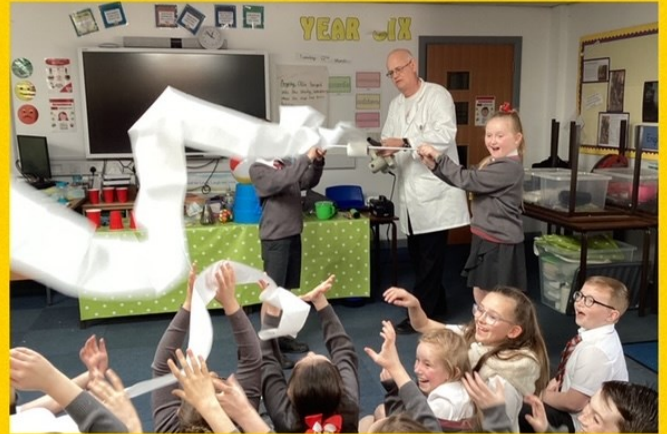
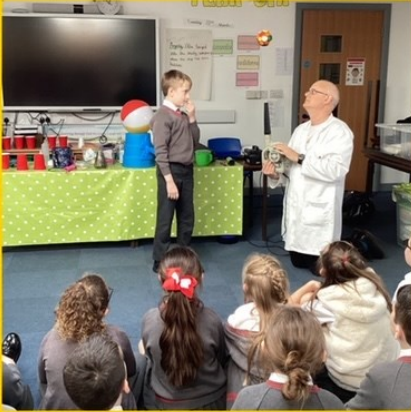
