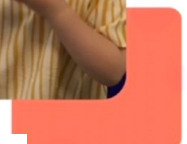

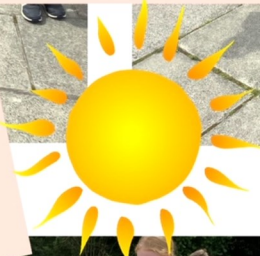




Today we learn that to make a shadow, the light has to be blocked. We call objects that block the light completely, opaque.



"The sun is behind me because my shadow is in front"



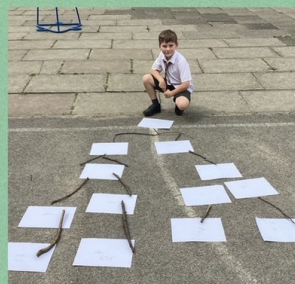
"The forest is shaded because of all the leaves blocking the sun"
