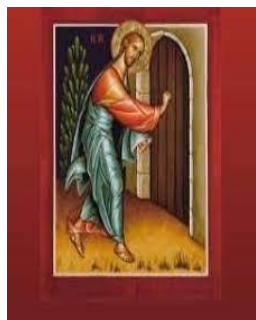

St. Michael's Church - under attack once more

St. Michael's Church and the grounds are still under attack from local youths, they are drinking and smoking drugs in the grounds. On Wednesday afternoon they broke 10 windows to the right of the crucifix in church, also banging and hammering on the door of the church whilst one lady volunteer was in Church, terrified.

Fr. Mark phoned the police and went straight down to St. Michael's to meet the police, but the vandals had gone. The police said we **MUST** report **EVERY** time we see these youths trespassing on the church property, **THEY DO NOT** have permission to be there, no matter what lies they tell. **YOU MUST** ring 101 and wait, report the incident and get a reference number, only when these logs add up will action be taken from the police force.

There is no point ringing the Parish Office or Fr. Mark when you see them in St. Michael's, this wastes time, you have a responsibility to keep our church safe too. **RING 101** if they are in the church or presbytery grounds or **RING 999** if they are causing damage.

We are now looking at CCTV to cover the site at St. Michael's, also in discussion with Cheshire Police.

Stations of the Cross at St Michael's Church

Last month we said that we hoped to have the paintings of 'The Stations of the Cross' at St Michael's Church restored professionally to their former glory.

Restorers have been out to look at the paintings and as you can imagine there is quite a lot of work needed to clean, repair and re-stretch the canvases and to frame them in new frames. The cost will be £1000 each to have them fully restored and framed.

The question is how as a parish can we fund this?

It is difficult times for many households at present and some parishioners may question whether we should carry out this work. However, whilst we still have our churches open, we do need to invest in them to keep them in a state fit for the worship of our Lord and something that we can be proud of.

The plan therefore is to go ahead with the restoration of the paintings. Fr Mark is planning to use any money received at his Jubilee Mass to help towards the restoration of one of the paintings. Invitations are extended to any family who would like to pay for one to be restored in memory of their family or a deceased loved one. A small plaque will be fitted to rear of the station acknowledging this.

Anyone can make donations to restoration fund, however small will be received with grateful thanks. Any donation over £500 will be recorded in the parish archive book being set up for the Restoration Project. The first three paintings will be taken away to be restored at the end of July and it is expected that the whole restoration project will take 12 months, only if we are able to raise the funds. If you feel that you would like to sponsor one of the paintings, you should let Fr. Thomas or Fr. Mark know. We would also encourage any individuals or parish groups who have any ideas for raising funds for the restoration to drop a line to the parish office.

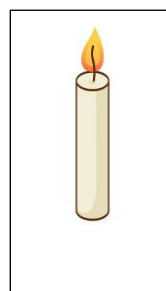
