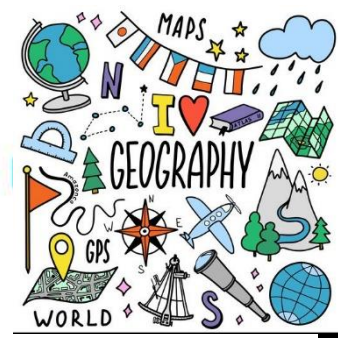
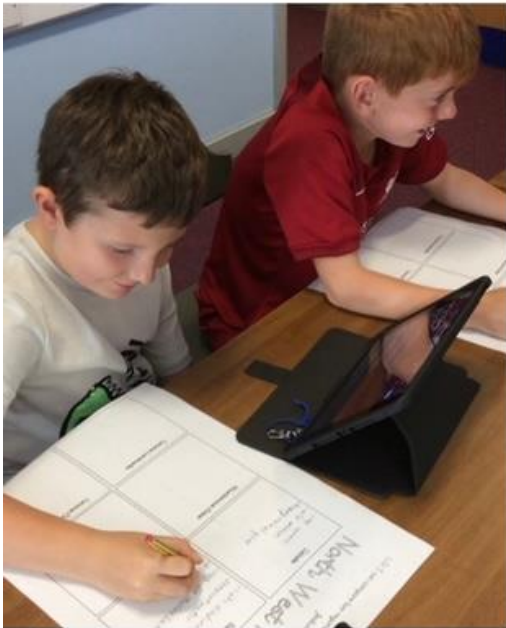

- You must complete a preference form online at www.halton.gov.uk/schooladmissions, where you will be given a receipt.
- A paper copy of the preference form can also be requested from schooladmissions@halton.gov.uk.
- All online applicants will receive their offer of a school place electronically on the 17th April 2023.
- Offer letters will be posted to applicants who submit a paper preference form on the 17th April 2023.
- Don't leave it too late** – you are likely to miss out on the school place you want if you apply late. **Deadline is 15th Jan 2023**
