Admission to Primary School September 2023

If your child was born between 01/09/2018 and 31/08/2019 they are eligible to start Reception class in September 2023, and you can apply NOW:

- You must complete a preference form **online** at www.halton.gov.uk/schooladmissions, where you will be given a receipt
- A paper copy of the preference form can also be requested from schooladmissions@halton.gov.uk
- All **online** applicants will receive their offer of a school place electronically on the 17th April 2023
- Offer letters will be posted to applicants who submit a paper preference form on the 17th April 2023
- **Don't leave it too late** – you are likely to miss out on the school place you want if you apply late. **Deadline is 15th Jan 2023**
